Advise to the students of knowledge

1: Allah(Subḥānahu wa ta'alā) says:

﴿ أَيَّامًا مَّعُنُ و دَاتٍ ﴾ الآية-

[Observing Saum (fasts)] for a fixed number of days (Al-Bagarah:184)

In this excellent month do not waste your time by saying he said and they said (chit chat / gossiping) and asking too many questions. The prophet() said:

Verily Allah likes three things for you and He disapproves three things for you. He is pleased with you that you worship Him and associate not anything with Him, that you hold fast the rope of Allah, and be not divided; and He disapproves for you irrelevant talk, persistent questioning and the wasting of wealth.

(Muslim: 1715)

2: Always remember the saying of Allah (Subḥānahu wa ta'alā):

﴿ وَوُضِعَ الْكِتَابُ فَتَرَى الْهُجُرِمِينَ مُشْفِقِينَ مِمَّا فِيهِ وَيَقُولُونَ يَا وَيُلَتَنَا مَالِ هُذَا الْكِتَابِ لَا اللهُ ا

And the Book (one's Record) will be placed (in the right hand for a believer in the Oneness of Allah, and in the left hand for a

disbeliever in the Oneness of Allah), and you will see the Mujrimun (criminals, polytheists, sinners, etc.), fearful of that which is (recorded) therein. They will say: "Woe to us! What sort of Book is this that leaves neither a small thing nor a big thing, but has recorded it with numbers!" And they will find all that they did, placed before them, and your Lord treats no one with injustice.

(Al-Kahf: 49)

3: Be patient and stay upon the path of taqwah, and do not forget the promise of Allah (Subḥānahu wa ta'alā):

But if you remain patient and become Al-Muttaqun, not the least harm will their cunning do to you. Surely, Allah surrounds all that they do. (Ale-Imran: 120)

4: Supplicate and remember Allah(Subḥānahu wa ta'alā) much. Allah(Subḥānahu wa ta'alā) says:

and remember the Name of Allah much (both with tongue and mind), so that you may be successful. (Al-Anfaal: 45)

Especially do Istighfar: Allah(Subḥānahu wa ta'alā) says:

And O my people! Ask forgiveness of your Lord and then repent to Him, He will send you (from the sky) abundant rain, and add

strength to your strength, so do not turn away as Mujrimun (criminals, disbelievers in the Oneness of Allah). (Hud: 52)

And this supplication . (حسبنا الله و لغم الوكيل) Allah (Subḥānahu wa ta'alā) says:

﴿ الَّذِينَ قَالَ لَهُمُ النَّاسُ إِنَّ النَّاسَ قَلْ جَمَعُوا لَكُمْ فَاخْشَوْهُمْ فَزَادَهُمْ إِيمَانًا وَقَالُوا حَسُبُنَا اللَّهِ وَاللَّهُ وَنِعْمَ اللَّهِ وَفَضْلٍ لَّمْ يَمْسَسُهُمْ سُوءٌ وَاتَّبَعُوا رِضُوَانَ اللَّهُ وَنِعْمَ اللَّهِ وَفَضْلٍ لَّمْ يَمْسَسُهُمْ سُوءٌ وَاتَّبَعُوا رِضُوَانَ اللَّهِ وَاللَّهُ ذُو فَضْلٍ عَظِيمٍ ﴾ اللَّهِ وَاللَّهُ ذُو فَضْلٍ عَظِيمٍ ﴾

Those (i.e. believers) unto whom the people (hypocrites) said, "Verily, the people (pagans) have gathered against you (a great army), therefore, fear them." But it (only) increased them in Faith, and they said: "Allah (Alone) is Sufficient for us, and He is the Best Disposer of affairs (for us)." (173) So they returned with Grace and Bounty from Allah. No harm touched them; and they followed the good Pleasure of Allah. And Allah is the Owner of Great Bounty. (Ale-Imran: 173-174)
